- 6. Why do you think Jesus used mud and spit to heal the man's blindness?
- 7. Why do you think Jesus told the man to wash in the pool of Siloam?
- 8. What was the man's response to being healed?
- 9. What was the response of the Pharisees to the man's healing?
- 10. How did the man's parents respond to the Pharisees' questioning?
- 11. What was the Pharisees' response to the man's testimony about Jesus?
- 12. How do you think the Pharisees' legalistic mindset affected their understanding of God and His actions?
- 13. In what ways can we sometimes be like the Pharisees in our thinking and actions?
- 14. Of the four characters in the story (the man, his family, his neighbours, and the Pharisees) who would you say you are more like? Why?
- 15. How does this story relate to your own experiences of seeing God work in your life?
- 16. What lessons can we learn from this story about the nature of God and the way He works? How can we apply those lessons to our lives?
