- 8. How does God see us in Jesus? Is that different than how we see ourselves and others?
- 9. What d you think are some of the ways people today find their identity? How does this differ from Paul's perspective in this passage?
- 10. We are not chosen for our own sake but for the sake of what God wants to accomplish through us. In what ways might God want to bless others through you and your church?
- 11. What blessings have we received through Jesus (v7-8)?
