Ice Breaker

- 1. Have you ever gone in a direction thinking it was the right direction but then end up lost? What was that experience like?
- 2. What would you be more likely to do if you got lost: Look at a map to figure out where you are, ask someone for directions, or keep driving, hoping you will get to where you want to go? Why?

Discussion Questions

- 1. What is something that stood out to you from this week's message? Do you have any questions about it?
- 2. Read Ephesians 2:1-10
- 3. If you had to summarize this section in one sentence, what would it be?
- 4. In this section, Paul divides our lives into two sections; what are they? What caused our change from one section to the other?
- 5. If left to our own devices, many of us would not naturally choose to follow God's instruction. Paul gives a reason for this in verses 1 and 2, what is it?
- 6. What, according to Paul, characterizes people who are going in the wrong direction?
- 7. What do you think it means when Paul says we were by nature objects of wrath?
- 8. In this section of the bible, how does Paul describe God's character? How have you seen these attributes of God's character in your own life?
- 9. Paul speaks in this passage about how before we were in Christ, we were dead and gratified our sinful desires. Even though we are made alive in Christ, do we ever rid ourselves of that desire to gratify our sinful desires? Or do things our own way and not Gods?
- 10. Why does God love us so much?
- 11. When you think about who you are, do you see yourself as made alive in Christ? How do you demonstrate that in your daily life?
- 12. Who do you know that you desire to know this truth, that they are dead in sin, but God loves them and wants them to be made alive?
