Going Deeper

- 3. Why do you think some people might be reluctant to join a small group?
- 4. Read Acts 2:41-47
- 5. Acts 2:41 says the number of people who believed the message Peter proclaimed was 3000. What did those 3000 start doing after they came to faith?
- 6. This section of scripture says they met daily in the temple courts and broke bread together in each others' homes. In Acts 5:42, it says day after day they met in the temple courts and each others' homes. Why do you think they met in both the temple courts and each others' homes?
- 7. What would have been the purpose of meeting in the temple courts? How would that have differed from meeting in someone's home?
- 8. Why do you think meeting in the temple courts and meeting in homes was necessary for early followers of Jesus to grow as disciples?
- 9. If we see the temple courts as our Sunday morning service and meeting in homes as being part of a small group, what would you say to someone who says you only need to go or watch the Sunday service and small groups are not necessary?
- 10. Who is someone you know who would benefit from being part of a small group? Pray for that person together and ask them if they would be interested in participating in your group sometime.
