2. Read John 2:1-12
3. Why do you think Jesus chose the wedding at Cana as the setting for his first miracle?
4. This is the first recorded miracle of Jesus in the book of John, chapter 2. How can the setting of a wedding help us understand the deeper meaning behind this miracle?
5. What do you think would have been the consequence of running out of wine? Why do you think Jesus cared?
6. Mary had a special relationship with Jesus and knew he was God, based on her interactions with the angel Gabriel and the miracles surrounding Jesus' birth. What can we learn from Mary's confidence in Jesus to solve the problem of the lack of wine?
7. How can we develop a similar confidence and trust in Jesus in our lives?
8. What is the significance of the instructions Jesus gave to the servants in performing the miracle?
9. Jesus told the servants to fill jars with water and then serve it to the master of the banquet. In what ways does this story demonstrate the importance of obedience in our relationship with Jesus?
10. What does obedience to Jesus look like?
11. How did the master of the banquet respond to the quality of the wine Jesus provided? What can this tell us about Jesus?
12. What do you think the purpose of this miracle was?
13. John uses the word "sign" to speak of Jesus' miracles, why do you think that is?
14. What "signs" have you seen of God working in your life and around you?
