- 1. Are you someone who likes to set New Years resolutions or goals? Do you have any for this year?
- 2. What adjectives would you use to describe God?

Going Deeper

- 1. Is there anything that stood out to you from Sunday's message, or do you have any questions?
- 2. How do you currently answer the question, "What is God like?" and what factors have contributed to your understanding?
- 3. This week's message emphasized the importance of knowing who God is. How do you personally seek to know God, and what role does Scripture play in that process?
- 4. Read John 1:1-18
- 5. Is there anything that stands out to you from this passage?
- 6. John uses the word logos to describe who Jesus is in this passage. How does John's portrayal of Jesus as the Word (logos) help us better understand who God is?
- 7. In the message, Rob discussed that John's initial audience may have understood the word 'logos' as the divine essence through which all creation came into being. In what ways can you see Jesus as the divine revelation of God's character in your own life?
- 8. Why is it significant that the Gospel of John presents Jesus as being present from the beginning and playing a central role in creation?
- 9. What do you think it means that in Jesus all grace and truth is found (v14)?
- 10. In the message this week, Rob said that if you want to know what God is like, you look at Jesus. How does Jesus serve as the answer to the question about what God is like?
- 11. In what ways can you reflect on Jesus' life and teachings to deepen your understanding of God's character?
- 12. What does it mean to 'come and see' who God is, and how can this be applied through the study of the Gospel of John?
- 13. Rob emphasized the invitation to explore Scripture and witness Jesus' life and teachings to gain insight into the heart of God. How can 'coming and seeing' lead to personal and spiritual growth in your own life?
- 14. What might prevent you from embracing the invitation to "come and see" who God is?
