7. In what ways does Jesus pray for future believers in John 17:20-23, and what implications does this have for us today?
8. In the message this week, Pastor Rob emphasized that Jesus' prayer for unity shows his deep desire for his followers to be united as a sign of God's love and Jesus' identity as the Son of God. How can you contribute to promoting unity within our church or small group?
