- 2. Read John 2:1-12
- 3. At this point, Jesus is not known as someone who does miracles. Why do you think Mary approached Jesus to tell them there was no wine? What do you think she was expecting to happen?
- 4. How did Jesus respond to Mary telling him they are out of wine?
- 5. Why do you think Jesus acted even though he had said his time had not come?
- 6. What is the significance of the jars? What were they used for?
- 7. Why do you think jars for ceremonial cleaning were used as part of this miracle?
- 8. Why do you think Jesus' first miracle was at a wedding?
- 9. How is this sign an example of the transforming power of God's love?
- 10. John tells us that the disciples put their faith in Jesus because they saw this sign. What made you put your faith in Jesus?
