8. On Sunday, David made the statement that Jesus is inclusive in his exclusivity. How do you understand that statement? How can you be inclusive and exclusive at the same time?
9. Is sharing with people the difference that Jesus has made in your life something that comes naturally to you? Why do you think it might be important to share with others why we believe in Jesus?
10. How might we proclaim and embody the significant message found in verse 6 in a humble and faithful way to the example Jesus set for us?
