2. Overf the last two weeks as we began this series called The Bible, we began exploring what the bible is and what to do with it. If someone who was not familiar with the bible asked you what it is and why you read it, what would you say to them?
3. One of the statements that Rob has emphasized about the bible is that it is not written to us, but it is for our use. What does that mean? Do you agree or disagree? Why?
4. What benefits have you experienced in reading or listening to your bible?
5. Read 2 Kings 22
6. Why would the king be hiring tradesmen to fix the temple?
7. Why is it significant that they find the book of the law?
